- We need to come up with a plan for Winter Workouts this year since the Y is going to be taking over the gym at the tech center. Possible use of

 - Church across from Sonoco has a gym Amanda to reach out
 - St. Rose has a gym Damian to reach out
 - Paradise also considering building a pole building Damian to reach out again
